

Personal Protective Equipment

What this Toolbox Talk Covers:

✓ The "Dos" and "Don'ts" for preventing workplace accidents and injuries by wearing the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).

Discussion Notes:

- ✓ Discuss the outcomes of the "Dos" and "Don'ts."
- **Do** Know which tasks require PPE, and use it every time you do those tasks.
 - Inspect PPE before each use. Look for cracks, tears, holes and other damage.
 - Ensure that your PPE fits correctly.
 - Store PPE in the correct designated spot after use.
 - Remember that you are responsible for wearing PPE when required.
 - Ask your supervisor if you are unsure whether PPE is required for a particular task..
 - Use the correct type of PPE for the task being completed. Clear goggles, for example, are not appropriate PPE to protect your eyes and face while welding.
 - Wear closed-toed shoes (with safety toes when working with heavy machinery) that have slip-resistant soles to prevent slips on the jobsite.
- **Don't** Use damaged PPE. If you discover PPE that is damaged, you should tag it, remove it from use and report it to your supervisor.
 - Remove PPE, even if you can do the job faster without it.
 - Wear the wrong size of PPE. Goggles, hard hats and face shields can be adjusted for comfort, but it is important that all PPE is the right fit.
 - Try to substitute ear protection with plain cotton in the ears. You should use approved hearing protection devices instead.
 - Wear sleeveless shirts or short pants.
